

DROPPING OFF & PICKING UP POLICY

RES has an open door policy, however we ask that all parents /guardians/ visitors follow the school policy for dropping off and picking up students.

Please enter through the main doors and signing in at the office before proceeding to another area of the school. Please do not just “slip in” to drop something off at a classroom or a child’s locker. We are a school of 430 students and interruptions or pop ins tend to be disruptive to the learning environment. If you are dropping off something for your child the office personnel will be happy to deliver it for you at one of the three break times during the school day.

Now that we have been in school for a few months, we are finding that students are settled into their school day routine. They are getting themselves out of their outside clothing and prepared for the start of the day unassisted. There are three breaks throughout the day where they must also dress and undress for outside recess. We ask that parents please do not come into the school with your child. With the increase in enrollment the hallways are extremely congested. We have homeroom teachers and support staff ready to assist any student that requires it. If there are kindergarten or new students that still require a bit of parental help we ask that your child enters their appropriate door and the parent enters the main door and sign in at the office. At the end of the school day we appreciate your waiting outside of the school at your child’s exit door.

For students that are picked up during the day for an appointment or due to illness: we ask that parents checking in at the office and sign out their child. Your child will be paged to the office to come and meet you. Students will not be allowed to exit the school on their own.

We thank you for helping to keep our students safe and following RES policies when it comes to dropping off and picking up students. Signs will be posted on our doors as a reminder.
