#### Parent Council Meeting

Since our Board Meeting in January, we have been getting busier and some of the highlights of my days until now include:

- 8. An Alberta School Board's virtual professional development day that included preparing for the upcoming election and a session on Lobbying Tools and Strategies for engaging the government in conversations about the needs of the school districts and education in Alberta
- 9. Attending a number of meetings regarding the hiring of a new Superintendent for Wolf Creek
- 10. Attending two Alberta School Boards Association meetings as the alternate Director for Zone 4
- 11. A Zoom meeting for the February Board meeting where we discussed the Election and the NEW BOUNDARIES FOR THE ELECTION
- 12. Setting a number of meetings including Board, Parent Council meeting on April 7 at 7:00 via Zoom, Advocacy Meeting after the Provincial Budget comes down, a Budget meeting to discuss the Provincial Budget, a Special Meeting to endorse the selection of the Superintendent and Assurance Model Training.
- 13. We met with the MLA's that represent our division Mr. Ron Orr and Mr. Jayson Nixon to impress upon them some of the needs and concerns of our district, among them the changes in Program Unit Funding, our Capital Plan that stresses the need for an elementary school in Blackfalds, Supporting Mental Health in Wolf Creek, COVID update for Wolf Creek and delaying the new K-6 Curriculum. We had good discussions and sent them a letter after the meeting just to confirm our discussions. Often they are not aware of what is happening in Education, so we wanted to make sure they had a follow up.

- 15. I have attended two Zone 4 meetings since we last met.
