"School councils are structured groups of parents, principals, teachers, secondary students and community representatives who work together to effectively support and enhance student learning. They provide a means for members of the school community to consult with and provide advice to the principal and the school board." - ASCA Website

Rimbey Elementary School Council should remember:

- the confidential nature of some school business.
- to limit the discussions at meetings to the business of the school as a whole.
- to keep meetings to a manageable timeframe.
- If someone would like something to be discussed at a meeting, they should ask for it to be added to the agenda PRIOR to the meeting.
- Only agenda items will be discussed at meetings.

Rimbey Elementary School Council should try to avoid:

- listening to individual complaints.
- discussing individual students, parents or staff.
