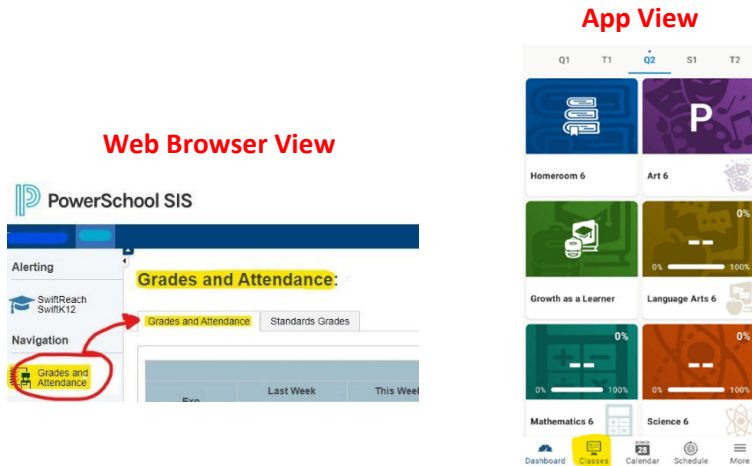


Parent Portal Instructions - Grades & Attendance

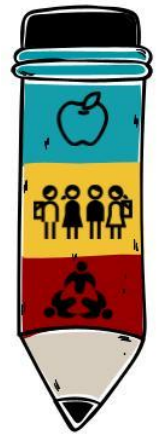

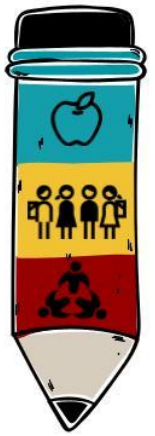
