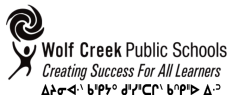

I am aware that there are certain limitations to confidentiality, and that they include:

- Reporting requirements under child protection legislation;
- Legal requirement to disclose;
- Imminent danger to the child, the guardian(s), the family, and/or anyone else;
- When the student's behaviour (words or actions) engages the implementation of the Threat Assessment Protocol;
- The disclosure is in the best interest of the child

In addition, I also provide consent for the District Maskwacis Cree Elder and/or the Cultural Support Worker(s) to consult with other professionals in the school district regarding my child on a need-to-know basis, and only when it is in the best interest of my child. I understand that I may put limitations on this contract if I do so in writing and deliver it to the Director of Indigenous Education and Reconciliation.

Wolf Creek Public Schools honours the histories, truths, and traditional knowledge of all Indigenous groups on Turtle Island. I am aware that histories, truths, and traditional knowledge of the Maskwacis Cree Elders and Cultural Support Worker(s) may be different from my family's.

I am aware that there will be, at a minimum, two upcoming parent information sessions for the Maskwacis Cree Elder and Cultural Support Worker Program in Wolf Creek Public Schools. All parents and guardians of students involved in this programming are strongly encouraged to attend. **These dates will be communicated with schools as soon as possible. Please contact school leadership or the Director of Indigenous Education and Reconciliation for more information.** Further details will be released to the schools closer to the date.

- Assisting with elder programming within the designated schools.
- May create, or support creation of smudge kits: providing sage kits for students and staff to utilize for self-care and spiritual support.
- May provide cultural support for students wanting to smudge, by welcoming them into a space where they can participate in that (as per AP 162).
- Supporting the elder(s) while they sit in classrooms with students with diverse needs.
- Assisting the Indigenous Education and Reconciliation Learning Support Coach with kits, presentations, and support as required.
- May provide workshops alongside the Elders and Indigenous Education and Reconciliation Team.
- May support planning of cultural events, presentations, and traditional ceremonies within schools across Wolf Creek.
